## What You'll Do

As a Consulting Analyst Intern, you will work alongside Agralytica staff on consulting projects that help organizations address complex challenges in agriculture, food, trade, market development, and risk management. This is a paid, three-month internship designed to provide real-world consulting experience and serve as a potential pathway to a full-time position.

You will be exposed to a range of clients and projects, which may include strategic planning for agricultural organizations, evaluations of market development programs, assessments of international markets, or research related to crop production and risk management. You will support project teams through research, analysis, writing, data organization, interview support, and deliverable preparation. This may include summarizing market trends, reviewing reports and public data, drafting portions of memos or presentations, preparing interview notes, organizing project materials, and helping staff develop client-ready deliverables.

Consulting work can be demanding and sometimes unpredictable. Project needs may shift over the course of the internship, and interns should be prepared to adapt to changing assignments and deadlines. Agralytica will provide supervision, feedback, and opportunities for professional development throughout the program. Interns will work alongside staff, mid-level managers, and partners who have extensive experience in strategic and management consulting.

High-performing interns may be considered for full-time employment after the internship, depending on performance, business needs, and project pipeline.

## What You'll Bring

Candidates must be recent graduates and are expected to work 40 hours a week in our Alexandria, Virginia office during the internship, as well as directly after, should they receive and accept an offer for a position. Relevant fields of study may include economics, business, agricultural economics, public policy, international affairs, political science, statistics, data analytics, communications, or related fields. Prior consulting experience is not required.

We are seeking candidates who are intellectually curious, analytical, detail-oriented, and interested in consulting work related to agriculture, food, trade, economics, public policy, business, or risk management. Candidates should be comfortable working on multiple assignments, asking thoughtful questions, receiving feedback, and contributing to a small, collaborative team.

Strong applicants will bring:

- Commitment to producing high-quality work and attention to detail
- Interest in agriculture, food systems, trade, economics, policy, strategy, or consulting
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Strong research and analytical abilities

## Additional Internship Details

The internship is expected to last approximately three months and will be paid at a rate of \$27.50 per hour. Interns are not eligible for Agralytica's employee benefits package, but would be if offered a full time position.

Interns must live within a reasonable commuting distance of our office in Alexandria, Virginia. Most of our work is performed from our office, though our clients conduct business across the United States and around the world. Interns may have opportunities to participate in client meetings or project discussions, though travel is not expected to be a regular component of the internship.
